"Whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask Me <u>anything</u> in My name, I will do it.

It will also come to pass that before they call, I will answer; and while they are still speaking, I will hear.

Isaiah 65:24 (NASB)

Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear; then your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of the LORD will be your rear guard.

Isaiah 58:8 (NIV)

O LORD my God, I cried to You for help and You healed me.

Psalm 30:2 (NASB)

And these signs will follow those who believe: in My name they will cast out demons...they will lay hands on the sick, and they <u>will</u> recover.

Mark 16:17-18 (NKJV)

When He went ashore, He saw a large crowd, and felt compassion for them and healed their sick.

Matthew 14:14 (NASB)

And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.

Luke 5:17 (NKJV)

And it happened that the father of Publius was lying in bed afflicted with recurrent fever and dysentery; and Paul went in to see him and after he had prayed, he laid his hands on him and healed him.

Acts 28:8 (NASB)

And He called the twelve to Himself, and began to send them out two by two, and gave them power over unclean spirits ... And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them.

Mark 6:7, 13 (NKJV)

As He entered a village, ten leprous men who stood at a distance met Him; and they raised their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" When He saw them, He said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they were going, they were cleansed.

Luke 17:12-14 (NASB)

No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;

Psalm 91:10 (NKJV)

They begged Jesus to let them touch just the edge of his coat, and all who touched it were healed.

Matthew 14:36 (NCV)

...so that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and <u>they were all healed</u>. Acts 5:15-16 (NKJV)

There he found a man named Aeneas, who had been bedridden eight years, for he was paralyzed. Peter said to him, "Aeneas, Jesus Christ heals you; get up and make your bed." Immediately he got up.

Acts 9:33-34 (NASB)

Then they brought him a demon-possessed man who was blind and mute, and Jesus healed him, so that he could both talk and see.

Matthew 12:22 (NASB)

He gives strength to the weary, And to him who lacks might He increases power. Though youths grow weary and tired, And vigorous young men stumble badly, Yet those who wait for the LORD Will gain new strength; They will mount up with wings like eagles, They will run and not get tired, They will walk and not become weary. Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the Church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord. Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, <u>that ye may be healed</u>. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

James 5:16 (KJV)

When He entered the house, the blind men came up to Him, and Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to Him, "Yes, Lord." Then He touched their eyes, saying, "It shall be done to you according to your faith." And their eyes were opened.

Matthew 9:28-30 (NASB)

He sent forth his word and healed them; He rescued them from the grave... Psalm 107:20 (NIV)

The whole town gathered at the door. Jesus healed many who had different kinds of sicknesses, and he forced many demons to leave people.

Mark 1:33-34 (NCV)

He had healed many people, and now everyone who had something wrong was pushing and shoving to get near and touch him.

Mark 3:10 (MSG)

And all the people were trying to touch Him, for power was coming from Him and healing them all.
